## SCCC MISSIONS NEWS AUGUST 2010

Our Mission as a Church and as individuals, is to get the Gospel message to those who don't know the love and saving grace of Jesus Christ. I have done some rough sums of what we do at SCCC.

In total, we support approximately 29 people in direct mission work both in Australia and overseas. These people work in 12 separate mission organisations, impacting on thousands of people.

At our last Management Committee meeting, the decision was made to provide support for a missionary couple working in Kununurra. They are Ps Roger and Ps Megan Garland. This family have planted a Church in Kununurra called Freedom Church. They received a vision to serve in the North 12 years ago, while based in Alice Springs. They completed theological degrees at Bible College and moved to Kununurra about 4 years ago. Roger and Megan are now working full time in the ministry with no support from outside. Please pray for this couple and their children.

**1<sup>st</sup> August:** Today we have Ivan Mills with us from "Christ for All Children". Ivan and Jane have been with us before and their last visit was about 3 years ago. Their vision is "To impart to leaders God's heart for children and to train and equip them in Children's ministry."

**8<sup>th</sup> August:** John and Jenny Davidson have planted an Aboriginal Church at Carnarvon. They have been there for about 3 years and have established a good foundation for the Church, building on relationships in the community. They will be attending the "Halls Creek Christian Aboriginal Convention" early August, doing a 4,000 km return trip in their 18 seater bus to attend. Pray they will have protection on the trip.

**15<sup>th</sup> August:** Please pray, as a new move by hard-line Islamic groups to fight "Christianization" is increasing religious tension in Bekasi just east of Jakarta, Indonesia.

**22<sup>nd</sup> August:** Oasis Outreach has reported good progress in establishing their self sufficiency program and is looking forward to sponsoring their next trainee to Geraldton before Christmas.

**29<sup>th</sup> August:** Hans Hansma's Seeds of Love Ministries; In the leprosy village, together with dedicated Thai workers, volunteers, and partners from Warner, we were able to cook and distribute well over 40,000 nutritious meals in this very needy place.
